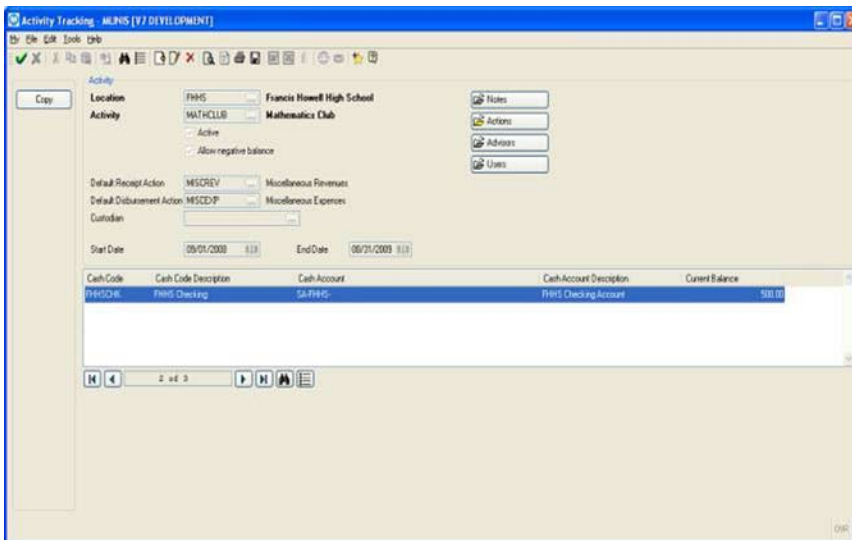
### Designed for Schools
